The main goal of this project is the development of a programme for a European trainer teacher tandem that enables participants to exchange and implement best-practice models. More specifically, this means that two trainers / teachers from different EU countries jointly deliver select parts of practical training in a business or other practical learning environment for a defined period of time. The important thing is that in some partner countries, such as Germany, Austria and Denmark, a dual VET system is practised, which is not, or not yet, the case in other countries, such as Spain, Greece and Italy.
