Returning to one's occupation after taking parental leave is often difficult because new technologies, working time models etc. have been introduced in the meantime, or the former job has been given to another person who has become well acquainted with the work. In many cases the persons affected "voluntarily" decide not to return to their jobs, or they are given notice to quit after the statutory reemployment period.

This project develops and tests a modular parttime qualification programme for workers on, or during the first year after, parental leave so as to facilitate occupational reintegration.

The programme specifically considers interests of the participants and the demands on the parts of employers, and is primarily aimed at updating and increasing knowledge relevant for the occupation in question. The main focus is placed on computer skills as such knowledge becomes outdated very quickly. In addition foreign modules dealing with languages. accounting and personal development have been prepared. Computer skills are also taught in a tele-learning home study module - with leased computers, autodidactical software and Internet access for the participants.

The programme is based on a modular structure, so the curricula may be adapted to the interests and time resources of the participants. Organisational and financial support are also provided for organising childcare during classes. Products: course programme outline, curricula, teaching materials, web site.

The goal of the project is to develop and test new instruments and problem-solving models that make it possible for society as a whole to draw on a broad range of personal and occupational competencies of older workers.

Project contents:

- Communication to younger workers of experience, competence and skills; for this purpose social and technical competence training schemes for older workers have been designed, aimed at consolidating their own social competence so that they may assist younger workers in developing their personalities, and at acquiring teaching skills to communicate technical competence and experience to younger workers.
- A quality assurance programme focussing on tourist and spare-time services for older persons and aimed both at the training of management-level employees and at new services offered to tourists over 40, has been started in several Salzkammergut regions.
- Application in the course of restructuring processes in enterprises: this model is being developed by the French partner, including participation in innovation and invention workshops, where new ideas are gathered and implemented in the form of new products for the target group 40+.

At the first stage this will be achieved by establishing Internet service offices, and at the second stage new teaching methods in connection with multimedia tele-learning systems will be developed and tested. The final step will be the qualification of workers in the context of a virtual classroom. A special tele-learning system has been devised for this project.

Two women's groups are trained to obtain the European Computer Driving License ECDL. This qualification is the necessary technical basis to be able to assess the content of a tele-learning system and the demand for tele-tutorials of specific groups.

Two modules of the ECDL (Spreadsheets, Database) are studied in a combined form of tele-learning and traditional classes, but in the case of the last two ECDL models (Presentation, Information and Communications) the participants prepare for the exams exclusively by tele-learning.

The two groups assess a tele-learning system by examining the contents of unknown subjects in tutored workshops. Parallel to this different forms of individual user support in a tele-learning system are developed and tested. The individual experience these women make of the methodical mix of a tele-tutorial will form the basis for the standardised development of a tele-tutorial. Based on insight gained in this way a training syllabus for tele-tutors is drawn up. So as a result of the overall project a curriculum for a teletutor training course has been made available; this concept has been developed in the course of the project and is thus based on empirical knowledge.
