In the module *Pinocchio* of *EPIMA 2*, 28 young asylum seekers in the province of Burgenland may take part in an intensive qualification programme.

The module is organised by bfi Burgenland, which, in co-operation with VHS Burgenland, an adult education institution, implements the programme in two regions: central and southern Burgenland. Its main objective is to provide vocational pre-qualification in preparation for a subsequent integration into the labour market. *Pinocchio*, a wooden puppet that comes to life, is a symbol of the aim to help young asylum seekers overcome the paralysed state of many months of waiting and to return to an active life.

The programme consists of

- German courses (two basic ones as well as an advanced one);
- one orientation and integration course;
- two parallel pre-qualification courses in the fields of woodworking occupations (aim: work as a carpenter) and tourism/catering (aim: work as a cook/in a restaurant), accompanied by
- individual coaching and counselling.

The courses extend over a total of 52 weeks; they are run from October 2005 to December 2006.

The *plan:b* Development Partnership aims to raise the employment rate among women in the central and southern regions of the province of Burgenland. It particularly addresses women with low qualification levels or whose qualification does not appear to be useful in the labour market. In addition, a model for reducing the disadvantages of this group is developed.

Module 5, in the remit of bfi Burgenland, is an analysis of potentials, based on the analysis of competencies carried out in Module 2. If necessary, this is complemented by additional training in essential skills, key qualifications and further special qualification (in non-traditional women's occupations, with regard to work-life-balance or oriented towards the requirements of the labour market in the tourism sector in southern Burgenland).

bfi Burgenland is also involved in Module 4, focusing on job and mobility management.

The goal of this project is to provide assistance for disadvantaged young people with regard to a sustainable integration into the labour market in the province of Salzburg.

New approaches to the training of young people, in particular appropriate measures for general, vocational and social education are jointly developed, tested and evaluated.

The basic model applied is the production school approach, and a network of already existing institutions is built. Another new feature is long-term counselling services for young people over a period of 15 months, from vocational orientation to qualification and integration into the labour market.

The qualification schemes offered aim to prepare the young people for the primary labour market, to help them develop a stable personality, recognise their strengths and deal with weaknesses.

This project especially focuses on the metal and building industries as well as tourism, for which traineeship capacities have been identified in the province of Salzburg.

For young people who are interested in occupations outside the above three industries or who do not yet know which type of occupation to aim at, profound orientation with occupational assistance and practical training is provided. Those completing the qualification stage of several months are issued with a competence certificate.

The central aim of this project is to generate interest in the work of a CNC machine operator and to teach the necessary know-how.

The project addresses students set to undergo training in the manufacturing industry, who may be interested in CNC machine operating. Other target groups are people who have completed school but do not have work experience and face disadvantages in the labour market because they have not obtained vocational orientation or practical experience, and persons who have worked in traditional manufacturing occupations (in the metal-working industry) and want to acquire more know-how in the field of CNC.

This project was preceded by a market study which showed that Europe does not have any adequate training schemes in this field, let alone e-learning programmes.

A model will be developed so that the skills and competencies taught at universities and in vocational training institutions in the context of business-oriented education and training may be assessed and compared to the demands of the labour market. For this purpose, recent graduates of such education and training institutions and their immediate superiors at work are given a questionnaire to assess whether the skills and competencies acquired meet the demands of the workplace and are relevant for professional careers, or whether other skills not covered by education and training would be needed for the occupation in question. In this way, deficits in education and training may be identified and curricula improved in order to meet the demands of the labour market.

MISLEM, by testing and refining quality indicators (such as the utilisation in the workplace of the skills and competencies acquired or the situation of graduates up to 12 months after having completed their training programme) significantly contributes to the quality assurance of education and training at universities and in vocational training institutions while at the same time taking into account the changing demands of the labour market.
